Pineapples: £3.30 each

Apples: 3 for £3.00

Oranges: 5 for £2.50

Bananas: 3 for £1.20

Tomatoes: 4 for £1.00

Cucumbers: 4 for 80p

Watermelons: £4.50 each

Andrew bought:

- 1 pineapple
- 6 apples
- 6 bananas
- 4 tomatoes
- a) How much did Andrew spend?
- b) How much change did Andrew get from £50?

Sally wants to buy:

- 1 apple
- 1 orange
- 1 banana
- 2 tomatoes
- 4 cucumbers

- a) How much did Sally spend?
- b) What is Sally's change from £20?

Tim bought at least one of each type of fruit. He spent £24.90. How many of each fruit did Tim buy?
