It comes before a noun in the sentence and lets us know to whom the noun belongs.

my your his her its our their whose

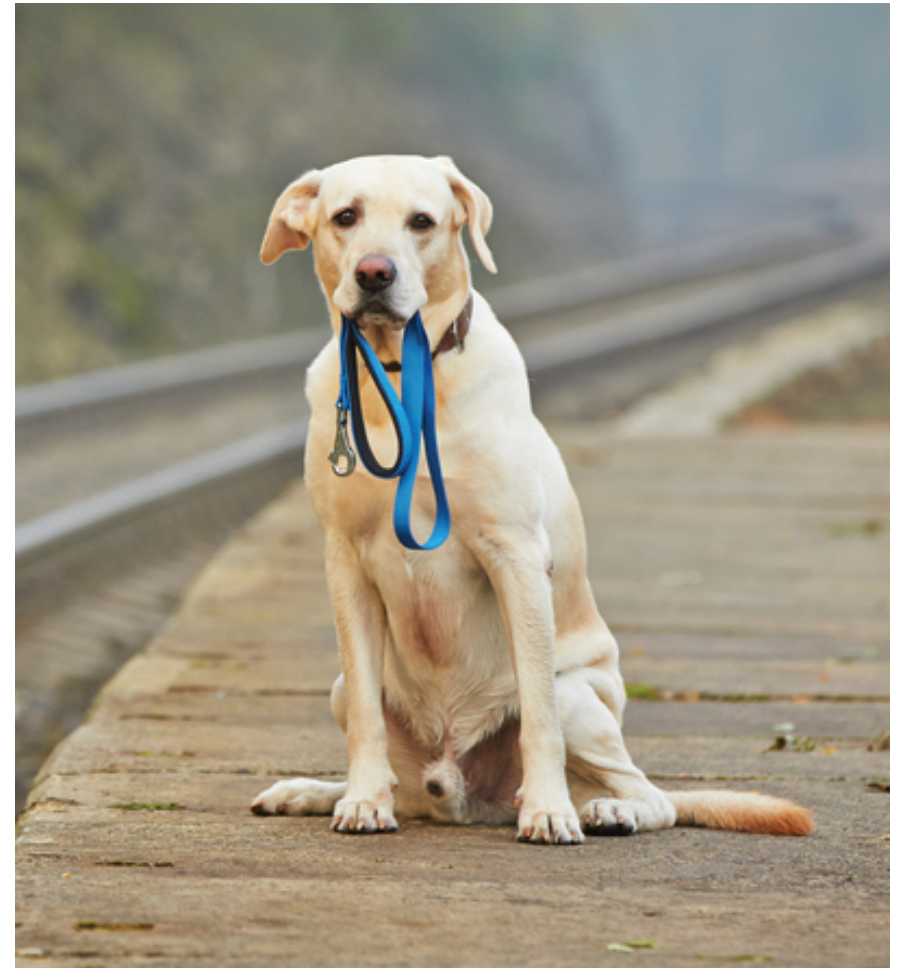
Whose dog is this?

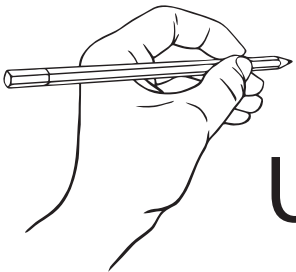
