

Comparative Adjectives

Comparative adjectives are used to compare two things.

We usually add **-er** to short adjectives and use **more** with longer adjectives.

This one is **shorter** than that one.

This book is **more interesting** than that book.



Comparative Adjectives

The word “than” usually accompanies the comparative.

Taurus is a smaller dog than Rex.

Venus is brighter than Pluto.



Spelling Rules

Adjectives ending in 'y'

For most adjectives that end with a 'y', we change the 'y' to 'i' and add 'er'

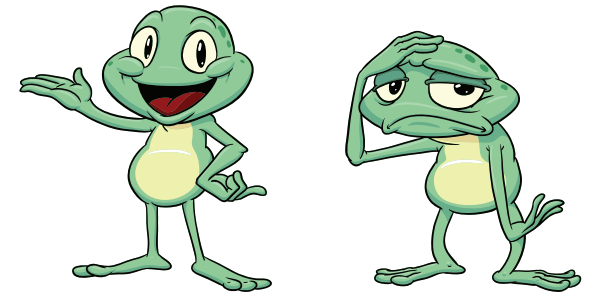
easy becomes _____
