

Koala Facts

• The koala is a marsupial that lives in Eastern Australia. Like the kangaroo and wombat, female koalas have a pouch in which they carry their young.



• They are nocturnal animals, feeding mostly at night on eucalyptus leaves.

- Koalas do not drink much water. They get most of the moisture they need from the leaves they eat.
- Koalas eat about one kilogram of eucalyptus leaves a day.
- Koalas sleep about 18 hours a day.
- The koala is the only marsupial without a tail.
- A baby koala is called a joey.
- About 100 years ago, the koala was hunted almost to extinction for its fur.
