Let's say where the cat sat, to make a more interesting sentence.

The cat sat on the mat.



the subject
that does the action
(noun)



the action
the predicate
(verb)



the object
that receives the action
(noun)

Simple Sentence Structure

The dog barked at
the cat.



The dog is the subject.

The action is the
barking

The cat is the
object receiving
the action.



Simple Sentence Structure



Write the subject first,
followed by the action
and then the object.

The boy swam in the sea.

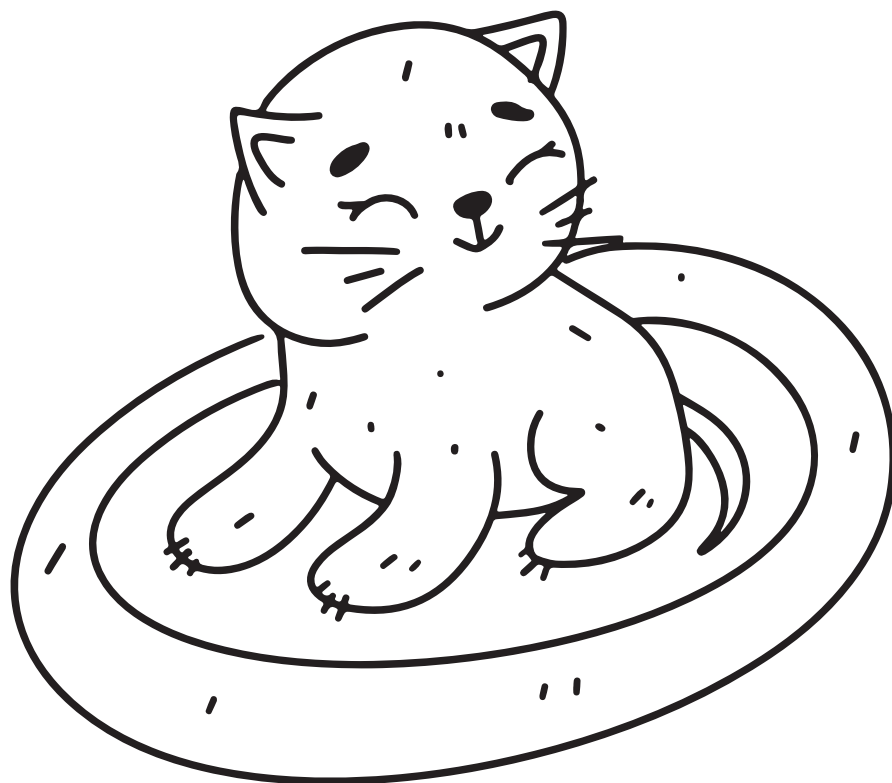
