

Nouns

A noun is a word for a person, place or thing.

person: man, woman, doctor, Harry, Hillary

place: home, town, countryside, Australia

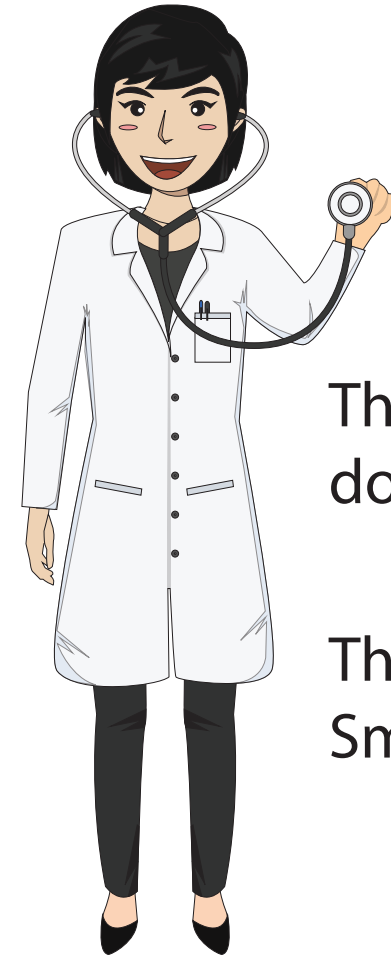
thing: chair, car, apple, money, dog, mouse

These can be divided into two types:
Common nouns and Proper nouns.

A common noun is the name of any ordinary person, place or thing.
e.g. shoe, tree, cat, whistle, beach, pear, girl

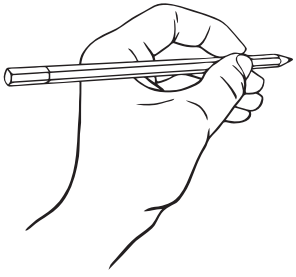
A proper noun is the actual name of a person, place or thing. Proper nouns start with capital letters.

e.g. Sunday, England, America, Tokyo, Sarah, Jonny, Captain Cook
