

Plurals: adding 'es'

Plural means more than one.

The plural of nouns ending in ch, sh, s, z and x are formed by adding 'es' to the end of the word.

More than one fox is foxes.

More than one bench is benches.

More than one wish is wishes.

More than one gas is gases.



Examples

brushes

buses

matches

churches

grasses

crosses

marshes

witches

mosses

patches

radishes

dishes

*Last Monday I saw a **fox** running over the hill.*

*Last Monday I saw three **foxes** running over the hill.*

*Sally used a thick **brush** to paint her picture.*

*Sally used different **brushes** to paint her picture.*
