# Descriptive Poetry

Descriptive poetry describes the world from the point of view of the author. These types of poems use imagery to describe places, people and events.

These poems will contain plenty of vivid adjectives which help to create an image in the reader's mind. Vivid sensory adjectives are words that describe sight, sound, feel, taste and smell.

Some examples of vivid adjectives include:

SIGHT- shimmering, fragile, speckled

SOUND- thunderous, whistling, gurgling

FEEL- elastic, shaggy, scorching

TASTE- delicate, luscious, spicy

SMELL- aromatic, fresh, floral
