Action verbs

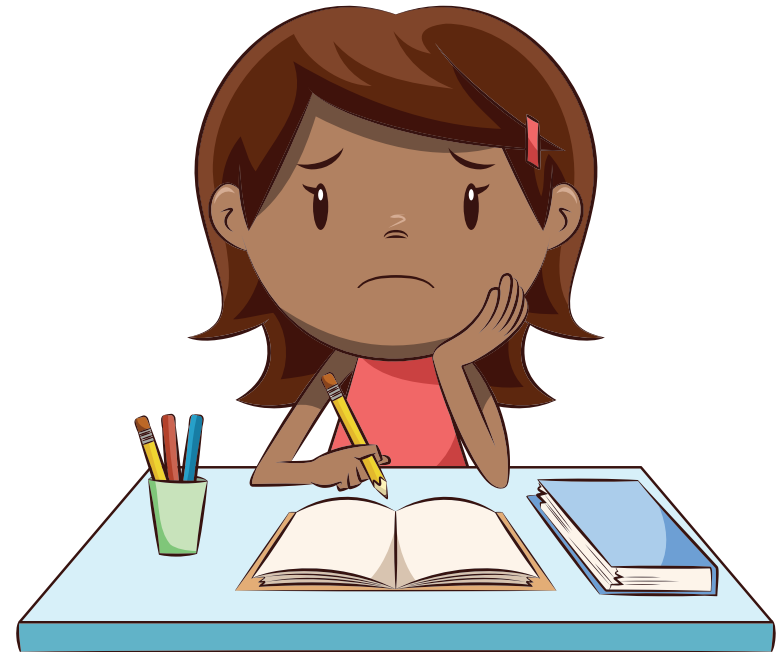
Action verbs can also be mental actions such as: think, ponder, imagine, believe, and wonder.
