

Homonyms

Homonyms are words that sound the same, have the same spelling, but have different meanings.

Examples:

iron - a type of metal.

iron - an appliance that's heated to press wrinkles from clothes.

iron - the act of pressing wrinkles from clothes (verb).

iron - a type of golf club.

Sentences:

They installed an iron gate.

Dad bought a new clothes iron.

I watched my sister iron the clothes.

He used a seven iron for the approach shot.



duck - a type of bird with a flat bill, webbed feet, and short legs.

duck - to lower your head.

bat - a type of club used in cricket or baseball.

bat - a nocturnal flying mammal.

bat - to wink or flutter your eyelashes.

crane - a large wading bird.

crane - to stretch your neck to get a better view.

crane - a machine to lift and move heavy objects.

can - a metal container.

can - the ability to do something.
