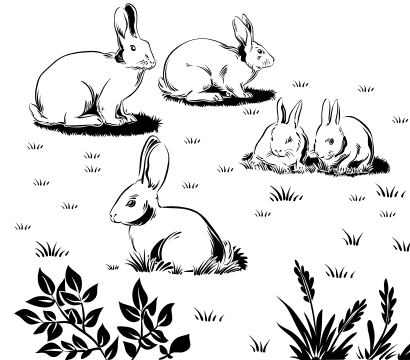
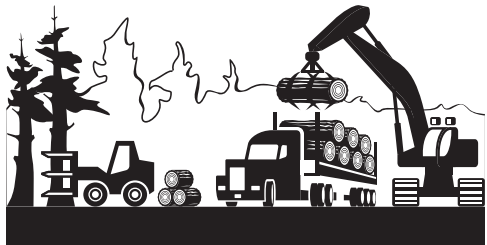

Loss of life due to disease.

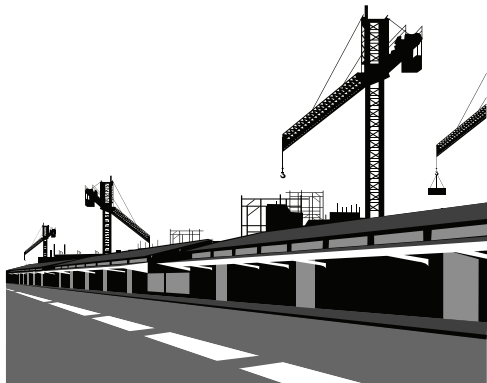
Reduced food sources due to competition from introduced species.
